

Eligibility Criteria

1. a) STC will provide precedence to applicants that represent one or more of the following:
 - Children and Youth;
 - Seniors;
 - Women in underrepresented occupations;
 - Aboriginal or Métis groups;
 - Registered charitable organizations or registered non-profit organizations;
 - STC business partners.
- b) STC will also consider supporting events, activities or projects which promote:
 - Education;
 - Youth sports, health and well-being;
 - Environment.
2. Applicants must be Saskatchewan based **and** initiative must be held in Saskatchewan.
3. STC will give priority to the communities it serves and events that benefit the greatest possible number of people.
4. Support will be provided under the following conditions:
 - Support will only be provided **once** in a calendar year to the same group or the same organization.
 - Support will be given to only **one version** of an event.
5. If applicant meets all criteria listed above and if financially feasible, one of the following support mechanisms may be considered by STC:
 - a) In-Kind Contributions

In-kind contributions are dependent on the availability of drivers, buses, equipment and storage capacity in terminals and the capacity of available trailers. In-kind contributions may take the form of the following:

 - Free or discounted parcel express services
 - Free or discounted passenger bus passes or tickets
 - Free or discounted waybills
 - Discounted charter services (very limited)
 - b) Prize Donations

A donation takes the similar form of an in-kind contribution or as a corporately branded promotional item(s).
 - c) Cash Donations

STC does **not** provide cash donations of any form to any organization or group.
